THE COACH

In three seasons, Chadron State College women's basketball coach Tim Connealy has helped rebuild the program.

In 2008-09, he led the Eagles to 11 wins, their most since the 2002-03 season, and he's followed that with two equally strong campaigns. In 2009-10, the Eagles narrowly missed on qualifying for the RMAC postseason tournament and in 2010-11 he helped guide CSC to an impressive win over nationally-ranked Colorado Christian.

To be sure, the Eagles have found their niche under Connealy and his free-flowing motion offense, as well as excelling with a pressure defense.

Connealy, a former graduate assistant and assistant head coach at the University of Nebraska-Kearney for four seasons, joined the Lopers in 2004. During his four years working under UNK head coach Carol Russell, the two helped lead the Lopers to an 84-46 record and a 57-19 mark in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference, including two NCAA tournament berths.

ADDITIONAL STAFF

Coach Connealy will be assisted by former players as well as current members of the Lady Eagles. These players have great basketball and camp experience to assist all campers. Our camper to coach ratio is kept low, 5:1, so campers can benefit from individual attention. A student trainer will be available to assist with injuries and training necessities.
