### Chadron State hosting Adams State

After getting on the winning track in its RMAC opener against Western State College, the Chadron State football team hopes to keep rolling this Saturday when it hosts another team from Colorado's high country—Adams State.

The Grizzlies are 2-1 for the season. They defeated Dixie State of Utah 24-14 in the season-opener and toppled Black Hills State 35-14 in Spearfish before losing 20-11 to undefeated Colorado State-Pueblo at home last Saturday night.

Adams State out-yarded Pueblo 317 to 295, but threw three interceptions and lost two fumbles. Several of the turnovers came when the Grizzlies were threatening to score. Chadron State defensive coordinator Todd Auer noted that the Adams State offense is a veteran outfit with capable players at the skill positions.

### Eagles are now 6-1 in their RMAC openers under O'Boyle

The Eagles have been successful in their RMAC openers under head coach Bill O'Boyle. After losing his first RMAC opening game, O'Boyle has led his troops to six straight wins, by an average score of 35-11. The Eagles opened up their 2011 RMAC season with a 15-7 victory over Western State.

### Enough with the injuries

The Chadron State football team has been struck with some bad luck and untimely injuries so far this season. The Eagles have lost six starters and a handful of them may be done for the season. They're currently missing tailbacks Dominic Morris and Glen Clinton, quarterback Jonn McLain, tackles Jake Blackburn and cornerback Talmaus Ewell. Blackburn and Clinton have yet to play this season, while Ewell, McLain and Morris are out for the remainder of the year.

### Chadron State beginning 97th season of football

Chadron State College is celebrating its centennial in 2011 but the Eagles will be in the midst of their 97th season of intercollegiate football this year. The football program began when the college was founded in 1911, but the college didn't field teams during World War I and World War II. The Eagles have an all-time record of 487-335-15.

## Madkins marvels in starting debut

Chadron State College's Michael Madkins and University of Nebraska-Kearney's Jake Spitzberger are Co-Offensive Nebraska Division II Players of the Week following their stellar performances last weekend.

Madkins, a sophomore from Elk Grove, Calif., ran for 235 yards on 26 carries and one touchdown in Chadron State's 15-7 win at Western State in Gunnison, Colo. Madkins, who was making his first career start, had carries of 38 and 40 yards in the victory. Madkins' rushing total is the most ever for a Chadron State running back making his first start and he is just the fifth CSC ball carrier to run for that many yards. Danny Woodhead did it 10 times, David Jones twice and David McCartney and Anthony Simmons once.

Spitzberger had 492 yards of total offense in UNK's 52-10 win over Colorado Mesa University.

## Winning after a loss

Since Chadron State head coach Bill O'Boyle took the job in 2005, the Eagles have been solid after losing a game. O'Boyle, who has lost 19 games in his career, has led his team to 12 victories following a defeat.

## X-Man

Sophomore Nathan Ross has had a stellar start to the 2011 season. The "X" wide receiver for Chadron State has caught 21 passes for 298 yards. In the opening game against the University of Mary, he had 12 receptions, tying him for the third most in a game in school history. Two weeks ago against Angelo State, he outdid himself by hauling in five receptions for 159 yards and a 73-yard TD. He also scored a 94-yard touchdown on a kickoff return. In 2010, Ross had 34 receptions for 455 yards and five touchdowns.

## Meet the Grizzlies' key players

The quarterback is Trevor Eggleston, a 6-foot-2, 200-pound junior who has completed 59 of 96 passes for 641 yards and has thrown for four touchdowns to match his interception total.

Last season, Eggleston completed 192 of 346 passes for 1,976 yards and nine touchdowns to go with eight interceptions.

Tailback Terjean Safford is a 5-8, 200-pound senior who has carried 73 times for 321 yards this fall. His twin brother, Torijeon, is his backup.

The top receivers are seniors Delton Prescott, who has 17 catches for 190 yards, and Dustin Bolt, who has 15 for 205 yards.

Another receiver, junior Scott Kellogg, led ASC last year with 48 receptions for 540 yards. Kellogg also was the RMAC's first-team all-conference punt returner in 2010. Kellogg's numbers also are outstanding this fall. He has returned five punts for a 15.2-yard average and seven kickoffs for a 23.3-yard average.

Rocco DeLorenzo, a 6-1, 230-pound senior, ranks among the best linebackers in the conference. DeLorenzo was a first-team all-RMAC choice last year when he participated in 99 tackles and was placed on the preseason all-star team for 2011.

## Nice debut

Junior quarterback Brandon Gorsuch had a solid debut for the Eagles last week against Western State. Gorsuch, who was making his first start since the 2009 season at Arizona Western, completed 11 of 20 passes for 88 yards and managed the game. The Eagles had nearly 40 minutes of possession time and converted 10 of 20 third down conversions.

## Ferdinand 'fer' the field goal

Since taking over the placekicking duties midway through the first game against the University of Mary, redshirt freshman Alex Ferdinand has been perfect. He's gone 5-for-5 on field goals and 8-for-8 on points after touchdowns. He has benefitted from the offense putting him in good field position. His longest field goal of the year is 33 yards.

# BILL O'BOYLE

Head Coach / Offensive Coordinator / Offensive Line Coach  
 7th Year as Head Coach/20th Year Overall  
 Alma Mater: Western Illinois (1987)



In his six seasons guiding the program, Bill O'Boyle has led the Eagles to national prominence. His teams posted three-straight undefeated regular seasons and won three Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Championships from 2006-2008. During that stretch the Eagles won a record 28 consecutive RMAC games. The Eagles also advanced into the quarterfinals of the NCAA Division II Quarterfinals in 2006 and 2007 and the second round in 2008.

Through six seasons, O'Boyle is already the school's second-winningest football coach with a record of 55-19 and a winning percentage of 74.3. His winning percentage was the third highest mark for active coaches in Division II entering the 2011 season.

O'Boyle, who stresses the importance of playing well at home, has an impressive record at Elliott Field. In six years, the Eagles are 29-7. One of those losses occurred in the playoffs.

On the road, O'Boyle has led CSC to a 26-12 record.

Combined with his time as an assistant coach, O'Boyle has been on the CSC sideline for 152 victories, over 30 percent of the school's all-time win total.

O'Boyle, who credits his coaching staff for the majority of CSC's success, received a huge honor in late 2007 when he was named the Liberty Mutual Division II Coach of the Year. He was chosen from a field of over 150 coaches and was featured in a

special that aired on ABC. With the award, O'Boyle received a \$50,000 cash award to support civic and charitable activities, as well as a \$20,000 scholarship donation to the school's alumni association. O'Boyle said he donated a large portion of the \$50,000 to Friends of Pets, a regional organization that finds homes for rescued dogs, as well as placing unwanted pets.

O'Boyle was also one of five finalists for the award in 2008.

In addition to the Liberty Mutual award, O'Boyle has been named the RMAC Coach of the Year three times and the American Football Coaches Association Region 5 Coach of the Year two times. He was also named the Sportex Division II Coach of the Year and Football Gazette National Coach of the Year in 2006. In 2006, O'Boyle was also the first Chadron State coach to be named the Lincoln Journal Star College Coach of the Year.

He has long been recognized as an exceptional offensive line coach, both from a technique and a motivational standpoint. After sharing the design of the offense and the play calling with Smith a couple of years, he took over as the offensive coordinator in 1999. Under his direction, the Eagles switched from the offset I to the spread formation as their basic offense.

The offense has been successful, particularly during his time as head coach. In six seasons, the Eagles have always finished in the top half of the conference for total offense and have averaged over 29 points every season of his tenure.

O'Boyle, 47, is in his second tour of duty with the Eagles. He spent the final three seasons of the 1980s as the offensive line coach, first as a graduate assistant and then as an assistant coach.

In 1990, he returned to his alma mater, Western Illinois University at Macomb, to begin a four-year stint as the Leathernecks' offensive line coach. But in January 1994, he rejoined the coaching staff at Chadron State, and assumed greater responsibilities for the offense.

A native of Des Moines, O'Boyle is a member of a "football family." Three of his five brothers have been or are high school head football coaches and the other two have been junior high head coaches and high school assistants.

During the summers, "OB," as he's known far and wide, has worked at numerous football camps, including the four team camps hosted by Chadron State.
