Eagles to host aerial-minded Skyhawks

After posting victories over the two New Mexico members of the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference the past two Saturday, the Chadron State football team will host the Fort Lewis Skyhawks this Saturday. Kickoff will be at noon.

The Eagles are 4-4 for the season and 4-2 in the conference. Fort Lewis, located at Durango, Colo., is 2-6 overall and 1-5 in the conference.

The Skyhawks opened the season by defeating South Dakota Mines 48-30 in the season opener. Northern Arizona, an NCAA Division 1-AA team, defeated them 58-13 in the other non-conference game.

In conference play, Fort Lewis beat Western State 27-10 two weeks ago, but has dropped the remaining contests.

Western New Mexico, which CSC defeated 21-13 last Saturday, edged the Skyhawks 13-8 in the first conference game for both teams. Since then, the Hawks have lost to RMAC leader Colorado State-Pueblo 47-0, Colorado Mines 33-11, Colorado Mesa 22-3 and to Adams State 46-0 last Saturday at home.

Coached by Cesar Rivas-Sandoval, who is in his second year as the head coach, the Skyhawks rely heavily on their passing attack to lead the offense. Tim Jenkins, a 6-foot-3, 220-pound junior, is a capable quarterback. He has completed 187 of 313 passes for 1,859 yards and nine touchdowns. He has been intercepted just seven times, or once every 45 passes.

The leading receivers include Jonathan Price, a 5-9, 170-pound junior from California who was planning to play at Nebraska-Omaha before that school dropped football last spring. Price then transferred to Fort Lewis. He has 34 receptions for 495 yards and two touchdowns. He also is averaging 22 yards on 12 kickoff returns.

Running back Van Gramann leads the Skyhawks in rushing with 75 carries for only 230 yards, but he has caught 35 passes out of the backfield for 269 yards. Another busy receiver is sophomore Blaise Cuban, a 5-7, 180-pound sophomore who had 30 catches for 287 yards.

The team's leading scorer is freshman placekicker Ryan Baldwin, who has made six of nine field goal attempts and all nine extra points.

With more players healthy, the Eagles seem to be gaining momentum. In the last three games, quarterback Brandon Gorsuch has completed 57 of 97 passes for 620 yards and five touchdowns while not being picked off.

Belville, Clinton earn accolades

James Belville has been named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference/Rawlings Defensive Player of the Week for his stellar performance in the Eagles' 21-13 victory at Western New Mexico last Saturday.

Belville, a senior from Valentine, Neb., helped lead a Chadron State defense that limited Western New Mexico to just 258 total yards. He finished with 2.5 sacks and three tackles for loss that accounted for a loss of 12 yards.

Belville leads the Eagles with six sacks and he's second with 57 total tackles.

The RMAC accolade wasn't the only one Belville earned following Saturday's win. He was also named the Nebraska Division II Defensive Player of the Week.

In addition to Belville, Chadron State's Glen Clinton was the offensive player of the week. He carried the ball 25 times for a season-high 148 yards. He also scored a TD.

Booming Borm

True freshman punter Josh Borm has been booming punts recently. The kicker from Cheyenne, Wyo., is 15th in the nation with an average punt of 42.5 yards. Thirteen of 39 punts have been inside the opponent's 20-yard line and nine have gone over 50 yards, including his long punt of 68 yards, which is the seventh longest in school history.

New faces are starting to become familiar ones

Some unfamiliar faces are starting to pop up in key situations for the Eagles this season. Due to injuries, several players are being counted on to perform and through the first four games, they've done well. Michael Madkins, who was third on the depth chart at tailback entering the fall, leads the team with 433 yards and three touchdowns. He's had seven plays go over 20 yards, including TD runs of 55 and 38 yards. Quarterback Brandon Gorsuch, who is starting in place of the injured Jonn McLain, has led the team to a 4-2 record, while completing 130 of 221 passes for 1,366 yards and nine touchdowns. In addition, right tackle Jake McCrary, starting center Sean McGowan and backup center Sam Parker have had to fill various roles on the offensive line.

Defensively, the Eagles have used three different cornerbacks trying to replace the injured Talmaus Ewell.

Inside guys

The inside receivers, or tight ends, for Chadron State have been great allies to the quarterback thus far in 2011. Through eight games the inside receivers - Jeff Alcorn, Cody Roes, Jeremy Sondrup and Chapman Ham - have combined to make 78 receptions for 908 yards and eight TDs.

Stellar linebackers proving their worth

Chadron State has a pair of outstanding linebackers - junior Kevin Lindholm and senior James Belville - who are leading the defensive unit. Lindholm leads the team with 64 tackles, while Belville has accounted for 57 stops, including a team-high 12 tackles for loss and 6.5 sacks. Belville has also forced a team-high three fumbles. In addition to leading the defense, both are team captains.

Smith back on the sidelines

Athletic director Brad Smith has been assigned the head coaching duties for the remainder of the 2011 season.

Smith was the Eagles' head football coach for 18 seasons, compiling a 133-56-1 record before devoting full time to being the athletic director at the end of the 2004 season. He said he will not become involved in the game strategy, but will be on the sidelines to lend support and help answer questions that may arise.

Ferdinand 'fer' the field goal

Since taking over the placekicking duties midway through the first game, redshirt freshman Alex Ferdinand has been nearly perfect. He's gone 9-for-10 on field goals and 22-for-23 on PATs. His longest field goal of the year is 41 yards.
