Eagles to host Mavericks in season finale

The Chadron State College football team will wrap up its season on Saturday by hosting the Colorado Mesa Mavericks. Kickoff is set for noon at Elliott Field. Colorado Mesa University, which was given a new name by the Colorado legislature earlier this year after previously being Mesa State College, is 4-6 for the season and 3-5 in the RMAC.

Chris Stein, who is in charge of the Eagles' offense, said the Mavericks have improved this season.

He noted that generally just the three linemen rush the passer and they have been a handful for the opposition. The trio is comprised of senior Connor Wright and juniors Justin Brown and Domonique Lewis.

All four of the Mesa linebackers are seniors. One of them, Chad Benkelman, a native of Elbert, Colo., spent his freshman year at Chadron State.

The safeties are brothers Trevor and Trent deBraga, both juniors. Trent has returned a pair of pass thefts for TDs and is averaging 26 yards on 22 kickoff returns and 10 yards on 13 punt returns.

Cornerback Travis McRae, a redshirt freshman, leads the team in interceptions with four that he has returned for 166 yards and two touchdowns.

Another redshirt freshman is the team's impact player on offense. Tailback Jake Cimolino, a 6-foot, 205-pound native of Fort Bragg, Calif., ranks second in the RMAC in rushing with 186 carries for 917 yards and five touchdowns.

Final game for Chadron State seniors

Saturday's game against Colorado Mesa University will be the final one for 13 Chadron State seniors. The group has combined to win 31 games and one RMAC championship during their four years together.

They are inside receivers Jeff Alcorn and Jeremy Sondrup, wide receiver Brandon Gunter, offensive linemen Jake Blackburn, Tim Hielt and Sean McGowan, quarterback Jake Iodence, defensive end Justin Trout, linebacker James Belville and long snapper Brit Williams. In addition, cornerback Talmaus Ewell missed what would have been his final season because of a knee injury, defensive lineman Maverick Churchill was sidelined by a shoulder injury after six games, and running back Dominic Morris has not played since suffering a head injury in the second game.

Chadron State closing its 97th season of football

Chadron State College has celebrated its centennial all year but the Eagles are about to close their 97th season of intercollegiate football. The football program began when the college was founded in 1911, but the college didn't field teams during World War I and World War II. Chadron State has an all-time record of 491-338-15.

Eagles looking to finish over .500

Following a 31-24 loss to Colorado Mines last Saturday, the Eagles are 5-5 for the season and need a victory to avoid finishing below .500 for just the second time since 1987. They are 5-3 in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference and can clinch fourth place in the 10-team league with a win.

Enough with the injuries

The Chadron State football team has been struck with bad luck and untimely injuries this season. In 2011, the Eagles have lost nine starters, including season-ending injuries for quarterback Jonn McLain, running back Dominic Morris, inside receiver Cody Roes, defensive back Talmaus Ewell, defensive tackle Maverick Churchill and cornerback Cody Wockenfuss.

New faces are starting to become familiar ones

Some unfamiliar faces are starting to pop up in key situations for the Eagles this season. In fact, during today's game against Mesa, two players who began the year as wide receivers - Conor Casey and Isaac Holscher - are expected to see extensive time in the defensive backfield because of injuries.

Other big contributors are Michael Madkins, who was third on the depth chart at tailback entering the fall, is second with 490 yards and three touchdowns. He's had 10 plays go over 20 yards, including TD runs of 55 and 38 yards.

Quarterback Brandon Gorsuch, who is starting in place of the injured Jonn McLain, has led the team to a 5-3 record, while completing 176 of 294 passes for 1,849 yards and 16 touchdowns. In addition, right tackle Jake McCrary, starting center Sean McGowan and backup center Sam Parker have had to fill various roles on the offensive line.

Inside guys

The inside receivers, or tight ends, for Chadron State have been great allies to the quarterback thus far in 2011. Through 10 games the inside receivers - Jeff Alcorn, Cody Roes, Jeremy Sondrup and Chapman Ham - have combined to make 102 receptions for 1,210 yards and 14 TDs.

Stellar linebackers proving their worth

Chadron State has a pair of outstanding linebackers - junior Kevin Lindholm and senior James Belville - who are leading the defensive unit. Lindholm leads the team with 77 tackles, while Belville has accounted for 68 stops, including a team-high 14 tackles for loss and 7.5 sacks. Belville has also forced a team-high four fumbles. In addition to leading the defense, both are team captains.

Smith back on the sidelines

Athletic director Brad Smith has been assigned the head coaching duties for the remainder of the 2011 season.

Smith was the Eagles' head football coach for 18 seasons, compiling a 133-56-1 record before devoting full time to being the athletic director at the end of the 2004 season. He said he will not become involved in the game strategy, but will be on the sidelines to lend support and help answer questions that may arise.

Ferdinand 'fer' the field goal

Since taking over the placekicking duties midway through the first game, redshirt freshman Alex Ferdinand has been nearly perfect. He's gone 11-for-12 on field goals and 31-for-32 on PATs. His longest field goal of the year is 41 yards.
