Third place in the RMAC on the line in Saturday's tilt

What shapes up as the battle for third place in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference football standings will be played Saturday afternoon when Chadron State takes on Colorado School of Mines in Golden. Kickoff will be at noon.

Both teams are 5-2 in the conference with two games remaining. Overall, Mines is 7-2 and the Eagles 5-4.

After breezing past William Jewell College of Missouri 33-0 and South Dakota Mines 55-7 in their non-conference games, the Orediggers were surprised 40-34 by New Mexico Highlands in their RMAC opener. The Cowboys scored in the final minute to spring the upset.

After that, coach Bob Stitt's team defeated Western New Mexico 27-21 and Fort Lewis 38-11 before falling to undefeated Colorado State-Pueblo 23-6. In the last three games, Mines has beaten Colorado Mesa 28-20, Western State 48-33 and Adams State 27-16.

"They're a good football team that won't beat themselves," CSC defensive coordinator Todd Auer said. "They have the best quarterback in the league and a big running back. They're not quite as experienced or maybe as fast at receiver as they were last year, but they don't drop passes. We'll have to find a way to slow them down."

The Miners are a relatively young team this fall. They start just two seniors on both offense and defense.

Quarterback Clay Garcia is one of the seniors. He was selected by the coaches as the RMAC's Preseason Offensive Player of the Year after leading the conference in passing and total offense last fall by completing 318 of 512 passes for 3,813 yards and 38 touchdowns. So far in 2011, he's hit on 225 of 367 tosses for 2,625 yards and 17 TDs. He's been intercepted just six times, but has been sacked 34 times.

The running back is Dan Palmer, a 6-foot-2, 235-pound junior who leads the conference in rushing and scoring with 181 carries for 888 yards and 16 touchdowns.

The Mines receiving corps suffered a jolt early this fall, when Cody Renken, a unanimous preseason all-conference choice, was injured. But others have stepped up. The leader is Diamond Gillis, a 6-0, 170-pound redshirt freshman who has 56 receptions for 593 yards.

Close behind Gillis are David Pawelek (6-3, 230) with 46 catches for 524 yards, Matt Brown (6-3, 205) with 34 for 422 yards and Jerrod Doucek (6-1, 185) with 29 for 429.

Booming Borm

True freshman punter Josh Borm has been booming punts recently. The kicker from Cheyenne, Wyo., is 17th in the nation with an average punt of 41.13 yards. Thirteen of 45 punts have been inside the opponent's 20-yard line and nine have gone over 50 yards, including his long punt of 68 yards, which is the seventh longest in school history.

New faces are starting to become familiar ones

Some unfamiliar faces are starting to pop up in key situations for the Eagles this season. Due to injuries, several players are being counted on to perform and through the first four games, they've done well. Michael Madkins, who was third on the depth chart at tailback entering the fall, is second with 476 yards and three touchdowns. He's had 10 plays go over 20 yards, including TD runs of 55 and 38 yards.

Quarterback Brandon Gorsuch, who is starting in place of the injured Jonn McLain, has led the team to a 5-2 record, while completing 154 of 257 passes for 1,616 yards and 13 touchdowns. In addition, right tackle Jake McCrary, starting center Sean McGowan and backup center Sam Parker have had to fill various roles on the offensive line.

Defensively, the Eagles have used three different cornerbacks trying to replace the injured Talmaus Ewell.

Inside guys

The inside receivers, or tight ends, for Chadron State have been great allies to the quarterback thus far in 2011. Through nine games the inside receivers - Jeff Alcorn, Cody Roes, Jeremy Sondrup and Chapman Ham - have combined to make 91 receptions for 1,077 yards and 11 TDs.

Stellar linebackers proving their worth

Chadron State has a pair of outstanding linebackers - junior Kevin Lindholm and senior James Belville - who are leading the defensive unit. Lindholm leads the team with 69 tackles, while Belville has accounted for 63 stops, including a team-high 13 tackles for loss and 6.5 sacks. Belville has also forced a team-high three fumbles. In addition to leading the defense, both are team captains.

Smith back on the sidelines

Athletic director Brad Smith has been assigned the head coaching duties for the remainder of the 2011 season.

Smith was the Eagles' head football coach for 18 seasons, compiling a 133-56-1 record before devoting full time to being the athletic director at the end of the 2004 season. He said he will not become involved in the game strategy, but will be on the sidelines to lend support and help answer questions that may arise.

Ferdinand 'fer' the field goal

Since taking over the placekicking duties midway through the first game, redshirt freshman Alex Ferdinand has been nearly perfect. He's gone 10-for-11 on field goals and 28-for-29 on PATs. His longest field goal of the year is 41 yards.
