### Something has to give when Eagles host Cowboys

Two teams who have both lost their last two games and have had their share of nail-biters this fall will collide Saturday at noon when the Chadron State Eagles host New Mexico Highlands.

The Eagles are 2-4 for the season with both wins and three of the losses decided by a touchdown or less and their other loss was by 10 points.

Highlands has a 4-2 record and all but a 60-14 blowout of winless Oklahoma Panhandle also have been decided by six or fewer points. Two of the Cowboys' games have gone into overtime.

After going 1-10 in both 2009 and 2010, Highlands has a new coach. He is Eric Young, who was the head coach at College of the Siskiyous, a junior college at Weed, Calif., the previous six seasons. Young and his staff have brought in a host of new players, most of them transfers, including several who have played for Division I teams.

The Cowboys opened the season by knocking off in-state rival Eastern New Mexico 43-36 in overtime after being scoreless at halftime. Following the romp over Panhandle, Highlands upset then-ranked Colorado Mines 40-34 by driving 80 yards for a touchdown in the final minute.

Highlands improved to 4-0 with a 41-38 victory over Colorado Mesa by going 69 yards in 12 plays and scoring the winning TD with just 11 seconds left. The Cowboys had 515 total net yards and sacked the Mesa quarterbacks five times.

The following week, Western State, which was winless, upset the Cowboys 15-14 by kicking five field goals, including a 27-yarder on the final play of the game. Last Saturday, Highlands led 24-13 at halftime, but did not score again. Adams State tied the game with a touchdown and two-point conversion late in regulation and won 30-24 in overtime after the Cowboys had fumbled on their overtime possession.

Starting quarterback Nick Ponce, who had completed 57 percent of his passes for 890 yards in three games, did not play against Adams State, and the Grizzlies out-yarded the Cowboys 453 to 266. The Cowboys completed only seven of 19 passes for 88 yards against the Grizzlies.

Running backs Jermaine Holmes with 89 carries for 484 yards and Jequerie Proctor with 90 rushes for 393 yards are the New Mexico team's leading rushers.

"They're hard to prepare for," Chadron State head coach Bill O'Boyle said. "We'll have to be ready for a lot different things. They definitely have talent."

## **Enough with the injuries**

The Chadron State football team has been struck with some bad luck and untimely injuries so far this season. The Eagles have lost seven starters and, unfortunately, cornerback Talmaus Ewell, quarterback Jonn McLain, tailback Dominic Morris and defensive tackle Maverick Churchill are out for the remainder of the year. Both Churchill and McLain were elected team captains at the beginning of the season.

The Eagles have also recently lost valuable special teams player and backup cornerback Tyler Wright to a leg injury.

Right tackle Jake Blackburn missed the first three games after recovering from a car accident. The same accident has kept alternate offensive lineman Mike Sandstrom out of action all season. The right side of the line wasn't the only side afflicted since left tackle Garrett Gilkey missed the first two games of 2011 after having an emergency appendectomy performed hours before the opening game against the University of Mary.

In addition, starting tailback and reigning RMAC Freshman of the Year Glen Clinton, missed the first three games of the season with a broken hand. He made his return three weeks ago against Adams State and has accounted for 225 yards and three TDs.

## **Booming Borm**

True freshman punter Josh Borm has been booming punts recently. The kicker from Cheyenne, Wyo., is sixth in the nation with an average punt of 42.7 yards. Nine of 29 punts have been inside the opponent's 20-yard line and seven have gone over 50 yards, including his long punt of 68 yards, which is the seventh longest in school history.

## **New faces are starting to become familiar ones**

Some unfamiliar faces are starting to pop up in key situations for the Eagles this season. Due to injuries, several players are being counted on to perform and through the first four games, they've done well. Michael Madkins, who was third on the depth chart at tailback entering the fall, leads the team with 402 yards and three touchdowns. He's had seven plays go over 20 yards, including TD runs of 55 and 38 yards.

Quarterback Brandon Gorsuch, who is starting in place of the injured Jonn McLain, has led the team to a 2-2 record, while completing 98 of 171 passes for 957 yards and four touchdowns. In addition, right tackle Jake McCrary, starting center Sean McGowan and backup center Sam Parker have had to fill various roles on the offensive line.

Defensively, the Eagles have used three different cornerbacks trying to replace the injured Talmaus Ewell.

## **Winning after a loss**

Since Chadron State head coach Bill O'Boyle took the job in 2005, the Eagles have been solid after losing a game. O'Boyle, who has lost 21 games in his career, has led his team to 12 victories following a defeat.

## **Ferdinand 'fer' the field goal**

Since taking over the placekicking duties midway through the first game, redshirt freshman Alex Ferdinand has been nearly perfect. He's gone 7-for-8 on field goals and 15-for-15 on PATs. His longest field goal of the year is 41 yards.

## **Inside guys**

The inside receivers, or tight ends, for Chadron State have been great allies to the quarterback thus far in 2011. Through five games the inside receivers - Jeff Alcorn, Cody Roes, Jeremy Sondrup and Chapman Ham - have combined to make 56 receptions for 647 yards and four TDs.

## **Stellar linebackers proving their worth**

Chadron State has a pair of outstanding linebackers - junior Kevin Lindholm and senior James Belville - who are leading the defensive unit. Lindholm leads the team with 49 tackles, while Belville has accounted for 46 stops, including a team-high eight tackles for loss. In addition to leading the defense, both are team captains.

# BILL O'BOYLE

Head Coach / Offensive Coordinator / Offensive Line Coach  
 7th Year as Head Coach/20th Year Overall  
 Alma Mater: Western Illinois (1987)



In his six seasons guiding the program, Bill O'Boyle has led the Eagles to national prominence. His teams posted three-straight undefeated regular seasons and won three Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Championships from 2006-2008. During that stretch the Eagles won a record 28 consecutive RMAC games. The Eagles also advanced into the quarterfinals of the NCAA Division II Quarterfinals in 2006 and 2007 and the second round in 2008.

Through six seasons, O'Boyle is already the school's second-winningest football coach with a record of 56-21 and a winning percentage of 72.7. His winning percentage was the third highest mark for active coaches in Division II entering the 2011 season.

O'Boyle, who stresses the importance of playing well at home, has an impressive record at Elliott Field. In six years, the Eagles are 30-8. One of those losses occurred in the playoffs.

On the road, O'Boyle has led CSC to a 26-13 record.

Combined with his time as an assistant coach, O'Boyle has been on the CSC sideline for 153 victories, over 30 percent of the school's all-time win total.

O'Boyle, who credits his coaching staff for the majority of CSC's success, received a huge honor in late 2007 when he was named the Liberty Mutual Division II Coach of the Year. He was chosen from a field of over 150 coaches and was featured in a

special that aired on ABC. With the award, O'Boyle received a \$50,000 cash award to support civic and charitable activities, as well as a \$20,000 scholarship donation to the school's alumni association. O'Boyle said he donated a large portion of the \$50,000 to Friends of Pets, a regional organization that finds homes for rescued dogs, as well as placing unwanted pets.

O'Boyle was also one of five finalists for the award in 2008.

In addition to the Liberty Mutual award, O'Boyle has been named the RMAC Coach of the Year three times and the American Football Coaches Association Region 5 Coach of the Year two times. He was also named the Sportexe Division II Coach of the Year and Football Gazette National Coach of the Year in 2006. In 2006, O'Boyle was also the first Chadron State coach to be named the Lincoln Journal Star College Coach of the Year.

He has long been recognized as an exceptional offensive line coach, both from a technique and a motivational standpoint. After sharing the design of the offense and the play calling with Smith a couple of years, he took over as the offensive coordinator in 1999. Under his direction, the Eagles switched from the offset I to the spread formation as their basic offense.

The offense has been successful, particularly during his time as head coach. In six seasons, the Eagles have always finished in the top half of the conference for total offense and have averaged over 29 points every season of his tenure.

O'Boyle, 47, is in his second tour of duty with the Eagles. He spent the final three seasons of the 1980s as the offensive line coach, first as a graduate assistant and then as an assistant coach.

In 1990, he returned to his alma mater, Western Illinois University at Macomb, to begin a four-year stint as the Leathernecks' offensive line coach. But in January 1994, he rejoined the coaching staff at Chadron State, and assumed greater responsibilities for the offense.

A native of Des Moines, O'Boyle is a member of a "football family." Three of his five brothers have been or are high school head football coaches and the other two have been junior high head coaches and high school assistants.

During the summers, "OB," as he's known far and wide, has worked at numerous football camps, including the four team camps hosted by Chadron State.
