Chadron State hosting No. 14 CSU-Pueblo

Nothing has come easy for the Chadron State College football team this fall and now it's really crunch time for the Eagles. Each of the next three opponents—Colorado State-Pueblo, Nebraska-Kearney and New Mexico Highlands—is 4-0 for the season. The first test comes Saturday when the Eagles host the Pueblo ThunderWolves during the featured attractions of CSC's homecoming and centennial celebration. Kickoff is set for 1:30 at Elliott Field.

Home sweet home

Chadron State has always played well at Elliott Field and head coach Bill O'Boyle's record at the friendly confines speaks to that. Since the 2005 season, O'Boyle's first, the Eagles own a record of 30 wins to just seven losses.

Record vs. Rank

In addition to being 30-7 at home since 2005, Chadron State is 5-3 at Elliott Field against ranked opponents. One of the losses came in the quarterfinals of the NCAA Division II playoffs to eventual runner-up Northwest Missouri State in 2007. The other two losses were courtesy of No. 14 Nebraska-Kearney (35-21) in 2010 and No. 5 Pittsburg State (38-31) in 2008. In its last game against a ranked foe, Chadron State defeated Colorado School of Mines, which was ranked 16th at the time, 38-31 in the home finale of 2010. Pueblo enters today's game ranked 14th.

Enough with the injuries

The Chadron State football team has been struck with some bad luck and untimely injuries so far this season. The Eagles have lost six starters and a handful of them are done for the season. Cornerback Talmaus Ewell, quarterback Jonn McLain and tailback Dominic Morris are out for the remainder of the year.

Chadron State beginning 97th season of football

Chadron State College is celebrating its centennial in 2011 but the Eagles will be in the midst of their 97th season of intercollegiate football this year. The football program began when the college was founded in 1911, but the college didn't field teams during World War I and World War II. The Eagles have an all-time record of 488-335-15.

New faces are starting to become familiar ones

Some unfamiliar faces are starting to pop up in key situations for the Eagles this season. Due to injuries, several players are being counted on to perform and through the first four games, they've done well. Michael Madkins, who was third on the depth chart at tailback entering the fall, leads the team with 350 yards and three touchdowns. He's had five plays go over 20 yards, including TD runs of 55 and 38 yards. Quarterback Brandon Gorsuch, who is starting in place of the injured Jonn McLain, has led the team to a 2-0 record, while completing 44 of 80 passes for 431 yards and three touchdowns. In addition, right tackle Jake McCreary, starting center Sean McGowan and backup center Sam Parker have had to fill various roles on the offensive line.

Defensively, the Eagles have used three different cornerbacks trying to replace the injured Talmaus Ewell, but the unit hasn't missed a beat, ranking in the top 50 in Division II in total defense.

Meet the ThunderWolves' key players

The ThunderWolves are rolling. After edging perennial power West Texas State A&M in Canyon 26-24 in the season-opener, they have defeated Northwestern Oklahoma 41-0, Adams State 20-11 and Fort Lewis 47-0.

Pueblo has won 24 of its 36 games, including 18 of 29 in the RMAC, since reviving football in 2008 after the sport had been discontinued in 1984 at what was then known as the University of Southern Colorado.

The running back is Jesse Lewis, a 5-foot-7, 180-pound senior who has carried 58 times for 350 yards and four touchdowns this season. He led the RMAC in rushing last fall with 1,391 yards and 14 TDs while averaging 7.9 yards a carry. Lewis is one of six ThunderWolves who were placed on the RMAC's preseason all-star team by the coaches this summer. The others are tight end Toby Wittek, offensive tackle Ryan Jensen, defensive end Grant Jansen, inside linebacker Lee Meisner, strong safety Josh Costa and Major.

Meisner was selected as the conference's preseason Defensive Player of the Year. After pitching two shutouts, the ThunderWolves lead the nation in scoring defense. They also have scored 15 of 16 times after reaching the red zone with Major kicking 12 field goals. In addition, they have intercepted 10 passes while not throwing any.

BILL O'BOYLE

In his six seasons guiding the program, Bill O'Boyle has led the Eagles to national prominence. His teams posted three-straight undefeated regular seasons and won three Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Championships from 2006-2008. During that stretch the Eagles won a record 28 consecutive RMAC games. The Eagles also advanced into the quarterfinals of the NCAA Division II Quarterfinals in 2006 and 2007 and the second round in 2008.

Through six seasons, O'Boyle is already the school's second-winningest football coach with a record of 56-19 and a winning percentage of 74.6. His winning percentage was the third highest mark for active coaches in Division II entering the 2011 season.

O'Boyle, who stresses the importance of playing well at home, has an impressive record at Elliott Field. In six years, the Eagles are 30-7. One of those losses occurred in the playoffs.

On the road, O'Boyle has led CSC to a 26-12 record.

Combined with his time as an assistant coach, O'Boyle has been on the CSC sideline for 153 victories, over 30 percent of the school's all-time win total.

O'Boyle, who credits his coaching staff for the majority of CSC's success, received a huge honor in late 2007 when he was named the Liberty Mutual Division II Coach of the Year. He was chosen from a field of over 150 coaches and was featured in a

special that aired on ABC. With the award, O'Boyle received a \$50,000 cash award to support civic and charitable activities, as well as a \$20,000 scholarship donation to the school's alumni association. O'Boyle said he donated a large portion of the \$50,000 to Friends of Pets, a regional organization that finds homes for rescued dogs, as well as placing unwanted pets.

O'Boyle was also one of five finalists for the award in 2008.

In addition to the Liberty Mutual award, O'Boyle has been named the RMAC Coach of the Year three times and the American Football Coaches Association Region 5 Coach of the Year two times. He was also named the Sportex Division II Coach of the Year and Football Gazette National Coach of the Year in 2006. In 2006, O'Boyle was also the first Chadron State coach to be named the Lincoln Journal Star College Coach of the Year.

He has long been recognized as an exceptional offensive line coach, both from a technique and a motivational standpoint. After sharing the design of the offense and the play calling with Smith a couple of years, he took over as the offensive coordinator in 1999. Under his direction, the Eagles switched from the offset I to the spread formation as their basic offense.

The offense has been successful, particularly during his time as head coach. In six seasons, the Eagles have always finished in the top half of the conference for total offense and have averaged over 29 points every season of his tenure.

O'Boyle, 47, is in his second tour of duty with the Eagles. He spent the final three seasons of the 1980s as the offensive line coach, first as a graduate assistant and then as an assistant coach.

In 1990, he returned to his alma mater, Western Illinois University at Macomb, to begin a four-year stint as the Leathernecks' offensive line coach. But in January 1994, he rejoined the coaching staff at Chadron State, and assumed greater responsibilities for the offense.

A native of Des Moines, O'Boyle is a member of a "football family." Three of his five brothers have been or are high school head football coaches and the other two have been junior high head coaches and high school assistants.

During the summers, "OB," as he's known far and wide, has worked at numerous football camps, including the four team camps hosted by Chadron State.
