Eagles are in for a tough test at Western N.M.

The Chadron State College pass defense is expected to be thoroughly tested Saturday when the Eagles meet Western New Mexico in an RMAC game in Silver City. Kickoff will be at noon.

While Adams State came from behind to win 44-40 last Saturday, Mustangs' quarterback David Ingram completed 29 of 48 passes for 487 yards and five touchdowns against the Grizzlies. Ingram, a senior from Irvine, Calif., also ran 61 yards for a touchdown early in the fourth quarter to give Western a 40-30 lead. However, Adams State responded with two late TDs to pull out the victory.

The Mustangs are 4-3 for the season and 3-2 in the RMAC. They split their non-conference games, defeating Sul Ross of Texas 35-28 in the opener, but losing 30-10 to the University of San Diego.

Ingram, who ranks second in the conference in passing, has completed 154 of 273 tosses for 1,925 yards and 16 touchdowns this fall. He has been intercepted eight times. His favorite receiver is Markis Sumpter, a 6-1, 160-pound junior who has 44 catches for 643 yards and seven touchdowns. Sumpter leads the RMAC in both number of receptions and yardage.

Another capable receiver for the Mustangs is Ronnel Pompey, a 5-10, 180-pound sophomore who has 33 receptions for 430 yards and three TDs.

The leading rusher is Daveon Barner, a 5-foot-7, 175-pound junior who has carried 89 times for 371 yards and five TDs. Barner rushed 15 times for just 40 yards against Adams State, but caught eight passes for 128 yards and a TD.

The right side of the Mustangs' offensive line features brothers Sunia and Sala Vatai, natives of Hawaii who are 6-4, 325 and 315 pounds, respectively.

The Mustangs' head coach is Adam Clark, who took over a year ago when WNMU went 4-7. Previously, Clark had been the defensive line coach and strength coach at Colorado Mines for two years. Before that, he was the defensive coordinator at his alma mater, St. Ambrose University at Davenport, Iowa.

Chadron State will make the 1,000 mile trip to Silver City by bus this year instead of flying as they had done the previous two times they went to Silver City since Western New Mexico joined the RMAC.

Enough with the injuries

The Chadron State football team has been struck with some bad luck and untimely injuries so far this season. The Eagles have lost seven starters and, unfortunately, cornerback Talmaus Ewell, quarterback Jonn McLain, tailback Dominic Morris and defensive tackle Maverick Churchill are out for the remainder of the year. Both Churchill and McLain were elected team captains at the beginning of the season.

The Eagles have also recently lost valuable special teams player and backup cornerback Tyler Wright to a leg injury.

Right tackle Jake Blackburn missed the first three games after recovering from a car accident. The same accident has kept alternate offensive lineman Mike Sandstrom out of action all season. The right side of the line wasn't the only side afflicted since left tackle Garrett Gilkey missed the first two games of 2011 after having an emergency appendectomy performed hours before the opening game against the University of Mary.

In addition, starting tailback and reigning RMAC Freshman of the Year Glen Clinton, missed the first three games of the season with a broken hand. He made his return four weeks ago against Adams State and has accounted for 272 yards and three TDs.

Booming Borm

True freshman punter Josh Borm has been booming punts recently. The kicker from Cheyenne, Wyo., is fifth in the nation with an average punt of 43.1 yards. Twelve of 34 punts have been inside the opponent's 20-yard line and nine have gone over 50 yards, including his long punt of 68 yards, which is the seventh longest in school history.

New faces are starting to become familiar ones

Some unfamiliar faces are starting to pop up in key situations for the Eagles this season. Due to injuries, several players are being counted on to perform and through the first four games, they've done well. Michael Madkins, who was third on the depth chart at tailback entering the fall, leads the team with 414 yards and three touchdowns. He's had seven plays go over 20 yards, including TD runs of 55 and 38 yards.

Quarterback Brandon Gorsuch, who is starting in place of the injured Jonn McLain, has led the team to a 3-2 record, while completing 111 of 188 passes for 1,087 yards and seven touchdowns. In addition, right tackle Jake McCrary, starting center Sean McGowan and backup center Sam Parker have had to fill various roles on the offensive line.

Defensively, the Eagles have used three different cornerbacks trying to replace the injured Talmaus Ewell.

Inside guys

The inside receivers, or tight ends, for Chadron State have been great allies to the quarterback thus far in 2011. Through five games the inside receivers - Jeff Alcorn, Cody Roes, Jeremy Sondrup and Chapman Ham - have combined to make 69 receptions for 761 yards and six TDs.

Stellar linebackers proving their worth

Chadron State has a pair of outstanding linebackers - junior Kevin Lindholm and senior James Belville - who are leading the defensive unit. Lindholm leads the team with 53 tackles, while Belville has accounted for 52 stops, including a team-high nine tackles for loss and four sacks. Belville has also forced a team-high three fumbles. In addition to leading the defense, both are team captains.

Smith back on the sidelines

Athletic director Brad Smith has been assigned the head coaching duties for the remainder of the 2011 season.

Smith was the Eagles' head football coach for 18 seasons, compiling a 133-56-1 record before devoting full time to being the athletic director at the end of the 2004 season. He said he will not become involved in the game strategy, but will be on the sidelines to lend support and help answer questions that may arise.
