Eagles look for first win at Western State

The season certainly hasn't gone as the Eagles expected it would, but they have an opportunity to get on the winning track when they play at Western State Saturday at 1 p.m. Both teams are 0-2 on the season, but more importantly, they open the RMAC state of the schedule with zero losses.

Becoming the 'CSC of the Western Slope'

There will be plenty of familiar faces on the Western State sideline. That's because four of its coaches learned part of their trade at Chadron State as graduate assistants. Head coach Jas Bains, who is in the midst of his first season as the main mentor at Western State, served as a graduate assistant and volunteer assistant at Chadron State from 2005-09. Bains, 29, was an excellent special teams and defensive backs coach at CSC. He became the defensive coordinator for the Mountaineers in 2010 and assumed the head coaching role earlier this spring. He's joined by offensive coordinator Tony Case, a former CSC graduate assistant, quarterbacks coach Ryan McDonough, another GA from CSC, and defensive line coach Mike Aimone, a former player and GA at Chadron State.

Eagles are 5-1 in their RMAC openers under O'Boyle

The Eagles have been successful in their RMAC openers under head coach Bill O'Boyle. After losing his first RMAC opening game, O'Boyle has led his troops to five straight wins, by an average score of 39-12. The Eagles opened up their 2010 RMAC season with a 40-7 victory over Western State.

Enough with the injuries

The Chadron State football team has been struck with some bad luck and untimely injuries so far this season. The Eagles have lost six starters and a handful of them may be done for the season. They're currently missing tailbacks Dominic Morris and Glen Clinton, quarterback Jonn McLain, tackles Jake Blackburn and Garrett Gilkey, and cornerback Talmaus Ewell. Blackburn, Clinton and Gilkey have yet to play this season, while Ewell, McLain and Morris are out for the remainder of the year.

Ross, McLain named Nebraska D-II Players of the Week

All three Division II schools in Nebraska share in the first awards of the 2011-12 academic year.

In football, Chadron State quarterback Jonn McLain is the offensive player of the week, while teammate Nathan Ross shares special teams honors with Wayne State's Kevin Paulsen.

On defense, Arthur Hobbs of Nebraska-Kearney is the top player.

McLain, a sophomore from Chadron, had his first 300-yard passing day in the Eagles' 49-42 setback to Angelo State. He completed 19 of 29 passes for 315 yards and added three touchdowns. It was the third time in 13 career games under center he tossed three TD passes.

Ross, a sophomore from San Diego, returned a kickoff 94 yards and finished the day with 130 return yards. He also caught five balls for 159 yards, including one that went for a 73-yard touchdown.

Winning after a loss

Since Chadron State head coach Bill O'Boyle took the job in 2005, the Eagles have been solid after losing a game. O'Boyle, who has lost 19 games in his career, has led his team to 11 victories following a defeat.

X-Man

Sophomore Nathan Ross has had a stellar start to the 2011 season. The "X" wide receiver for Chadron State has caught 17 passes for 279 yards. In the opening game against the University of Mary, he had 12 receptions, tying him for the third most in a game in school history. Last week against Angelo State, he outdid himself by hauling in five receptions for 159 yards and a 73-yard TD. He also scored a 94-yard touchdown on a kickoff return. His kickoff return is the third longest in school history. In 2010, Ross had 34 receptions for 455 yards and five touchdowns.

Big play Nate

In just two games, Nathan Ross has gained at least 20 yards six different times and 11 of his 17 receptions have resulted in first downs.

In fact, Ross is currently leading Division II in all-purpose yardage during a game, averaging 248.0 yards. He's also ranked fifth in receiving yards per game (139.5), sixth in receptions per game (8.5) and seventh in kickoff returns (36.17).

Morris is on the road to recovery

Tailback Dominic Morris was released from Regional West Medical Center in Scottsbluff Tuesday morning following a hit during Saturday's game against Angelo State.

According to Chadron State head athletic trainer Don Watt, the tackle caused bleeding around Morris' brain, which led to the formation of a blood clot that caused neuromuscular complications. Surgeons at operated on Morris for about three hours and the procedure went well.

Following the operation Saturday night, Morris was alert and showed no signs of any ill effects from the injury.

Meet your new backfield

In addition to Brandon Gorsuch making his first career start at quarterback, two young tailbacks will be seeing more action. Michael Madkins, a sophomore from Elk Grove, Calif., who rushed for a 25-yard TD against Angelo State last week, is expected to get the starting nod. Jojo Phillips, a redshirt freshman from La Mesa, Calif., will also see some carries.

Madkins wasn't with the team a season ago but he redshirted in 2009. While he was a senior at Pleasant Grove High School he rushed for 1,948 yards on 324 carries and scored 19 TDs.

Phillips suffered a shoulder injury in 2010 after redshirting in 2009. In 2008 at Helix Charter High School, he ran for 441 yards on 51 carries and scored five touchdowns out of the backfield. He was high school teammates with current CSC player, Trelan Taylor.

BILL O'BOYLE

In his six seasons guiding the program, Bill O'Boyle has led the Eagles to national prominence. His teams posted three-straight undefeated regular seasons and won three Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Championships from 2006-2008. During that stretch the Eagles won a record 28 consecutive RMAC games. The Eagles also advanced into the quarterfinals of the NCAA Division II Quarterfinals in 2006 and 2007 and the second round in 2008.

Through six seasons, O'Boyle is already the school's second-winningest football coach with a record of 54-19 and a winning percentage of 73.9. His winning percentage is the third highest mark for active coaches in Division II entering the 2011 season.

O'Boyle, who stresses the importance of playing well at home, has an impressive record at Elliott Field. In six years, the Eagles are 29-7. One of those losses occurred in the playoffs.

On the road, O'Boyle has led CSC to a 25-12 record.

Combined with his time as an assistant coach, O'Boyle has been on the CSC sideline for 151 victories, over 30 percent of the school's all-time win total.

O'Boyle, who credits his coaching staff for the majority of CSC's success, received a huge honor in late 2007 when he was named the Liberty Mutual Division II Coach of the Year. He was chosen from a field of over 150 coaches and was featured in a

special that aired on ABC. With the award, O'Boyle received a \$50,000 cash award to support civic and charitable activities, as well as a \$20,000 scholarship donation to the school's alumni association. O'Boyle said he donated a large portion of the \$50,000 to Friends of Pets, a regional organization that finds homes for rescued dogs, as well as placing unwanted pets.

O'Boyle was also one of five finalists for the award in 2008.

In addition to the Liberty Mutual award, O'Boyle has been named the RMAC Coach of the Year three times and the American Football Coaches Association Region 5 Coach of the Year two times. He was also named the Sportex Division II Coach of the Year and Football Gazette National Coach of the Year in 2006. In 2006, O'Boyle was also the first Chadron State coach to be named the Lincoln Journal Star College Coach of the Year.

He has long been recognized as an exceptional offensive line coach, both from a technique and a motivational standpoint. After sharing the design of the offense and the play calling with Smith a couple of years, he took over as the offensive coordinator in 1999. Under his direction, the Eagles switched from the offset I to the spread formation as their basic offense.

The offense has been successful, particularly during his time as head coach. In six seasons, the Eagles have always finished in the top half of the conference for total offense and have averaged over 29 points every season of his tenure.

O'Boyle, 47, is in his second tour of duty with the Eagles. He spent the final three seasons of the 1980s as the offensive line coach, first as a graduate assistant and then as an assistant coach.

In 1990, he returned to his alma mater, Western Illinois University at Macomb, to begin a four-year stint as the Leathernecks' offensive line coach. But in January 1994, he rejoined the coaching staff at Chadron State, and assumed greater responsibilities for the offense.

A native of Des Moines, O'Boyle is a member of a "football family." Three of his five brothers have been or are high school head football coaches and the other two have been junior high head coaches and high school assistants.

During the summers, "OB," as he's known far and wide, has worked at numerous football camps, including the four team camps hosted by Chadron State.
