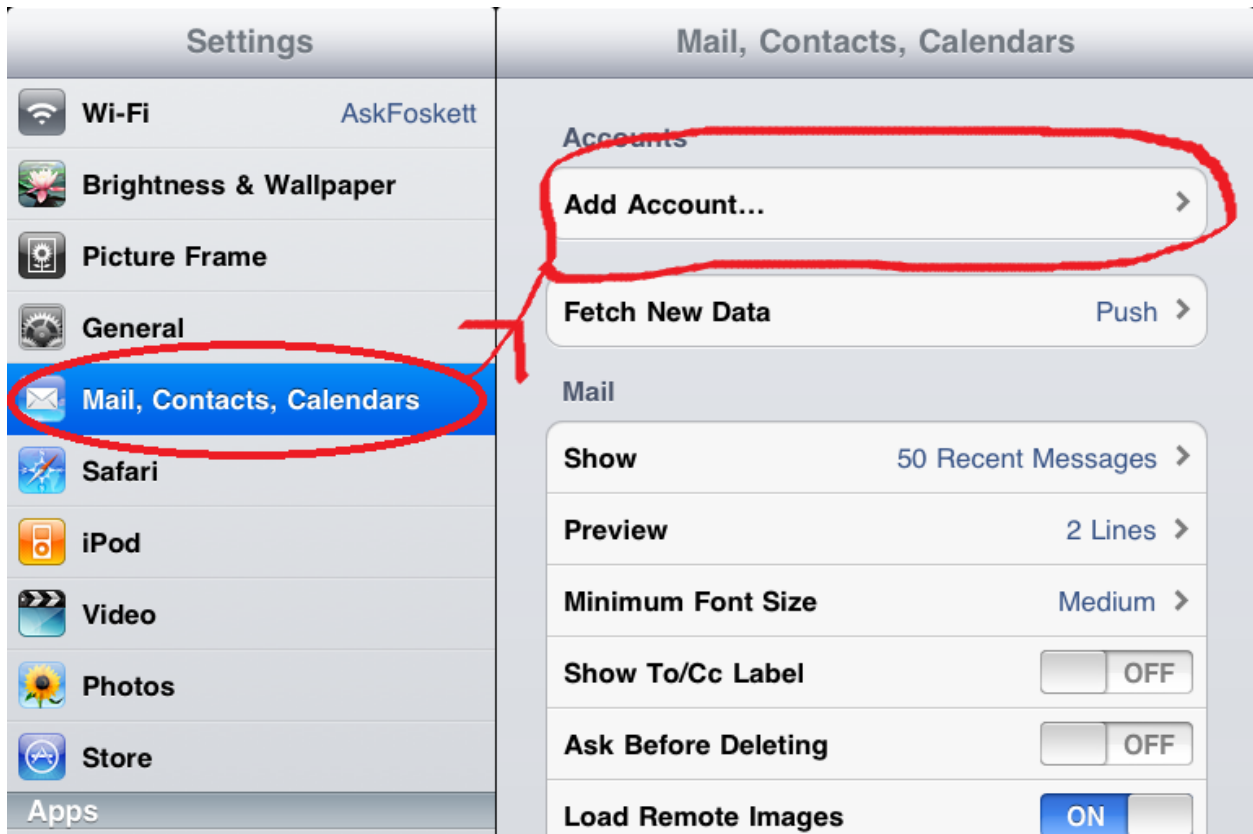


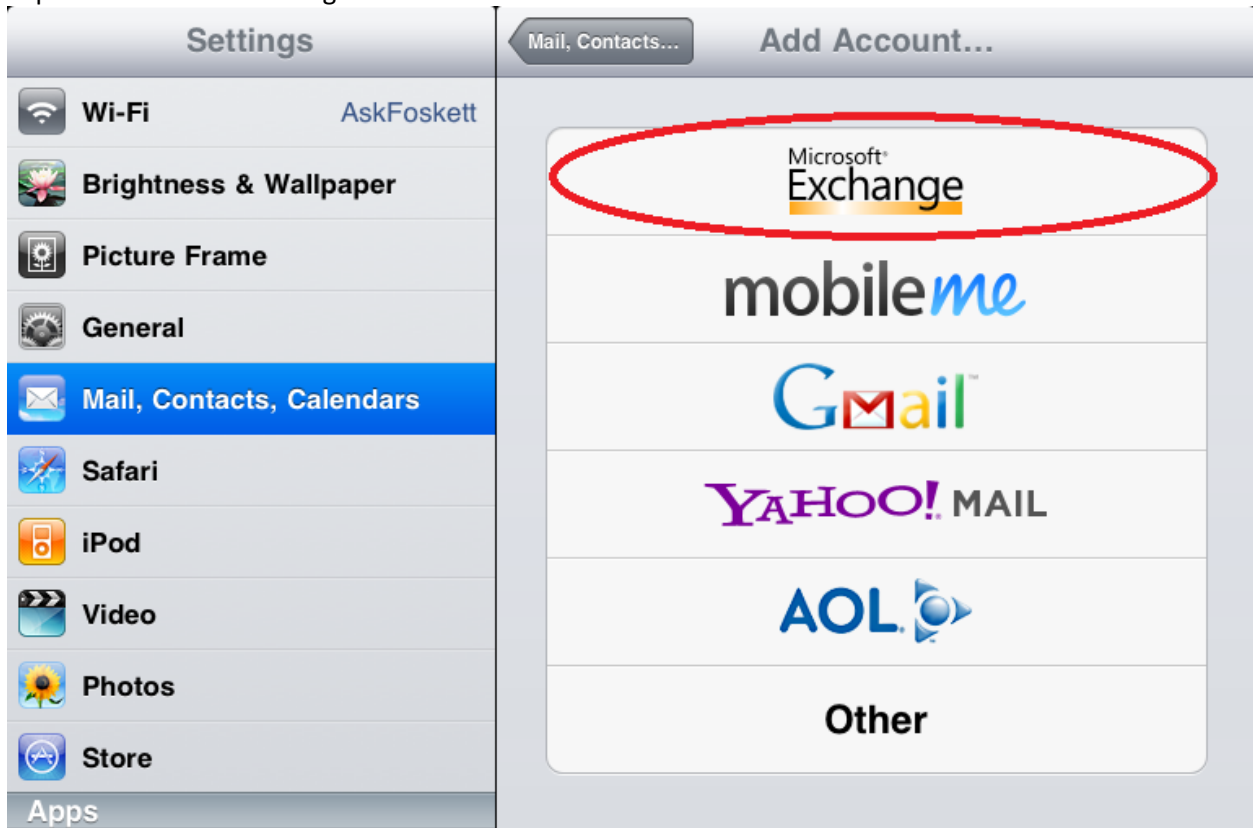
## iPad email/Exchange configuration

Tap the “Settings” icon from the home screen, then “Mail, Contacts, Calendars”



In “Mail, Contacts, Calendars”, tap “Add Account...”

Tap the "Microsoft Exchange" icon



Enter Exchange account information as follows:

Email: your **username@csc.edu**

Domain: **orn.csc.edu**

Username: **username**

Password: **your account password**



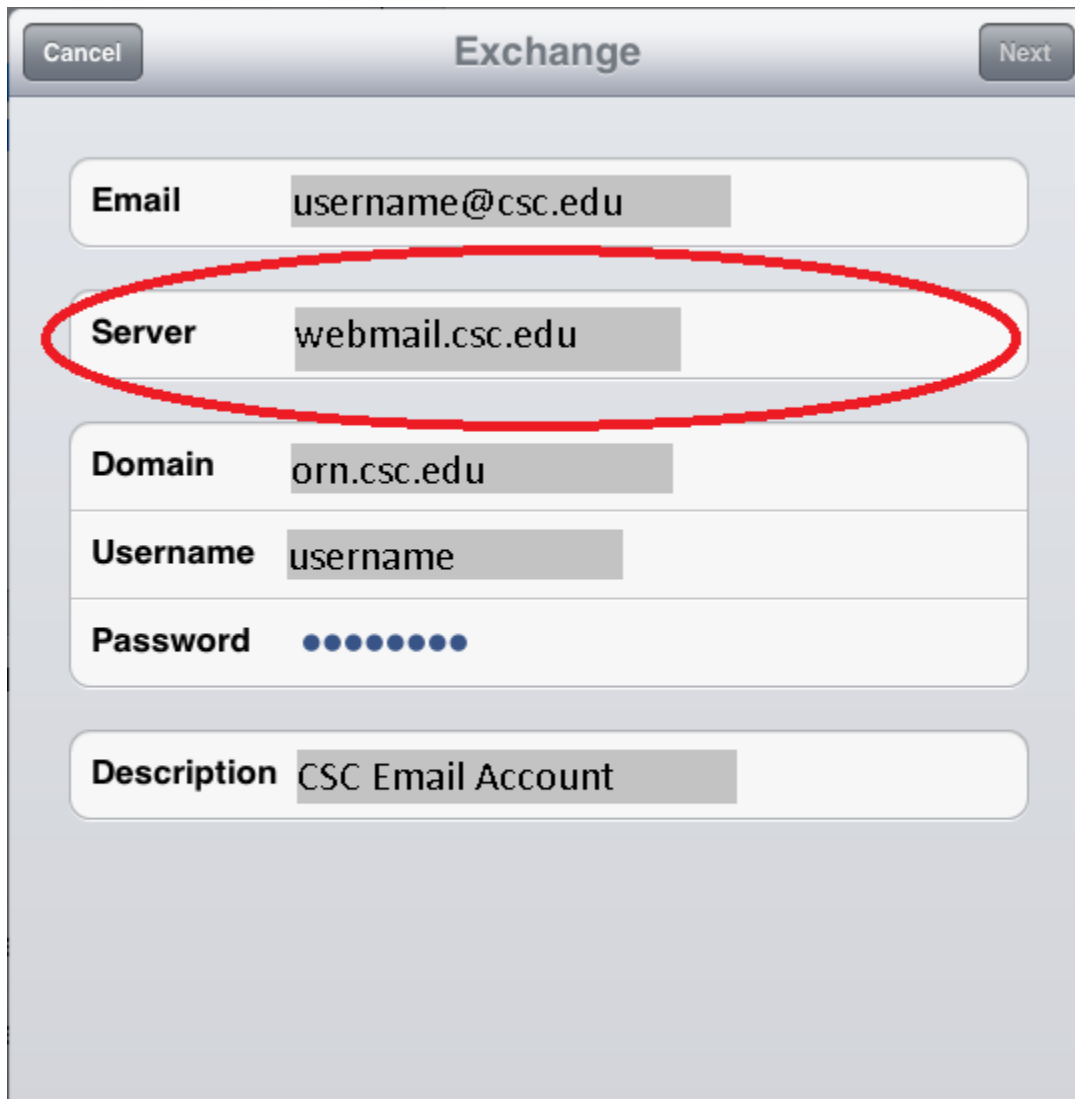

Tap the "Next" button

Enter the Server information as follows:

Server: **webmail.csc.edu**

Tap "Next" and the iPad will verify the configuration

By default, the iPad will synchronize all data types (Mail, Contacts, Calendars and Reminders) with the Exchange email server



Tap "Save" and the iPad will finalize the configuration and return to the "Mail, Contacts, Calendars" menu while the iPad communicates with the server

*Note:* It can take a few minutes for calendar entries and contacts to show up
