CHADRON STATE COLLEGE FIRST DESTINATION REPORT

Each year the Office of Career and Academic Planning Services produces a report about the previous year's graduates. This report covers graduates that received Bachelor's or Master's degrees. This information is intended to assist currently enrolled and prospective students in selecting academic majors and making career decisions. Information was collected through the use of a survey sent to graduates three months after graduating. An electronic survey was also available at graduation rehearsal and noted in the mailing.

This report represents 24% of bachelor's degrees graduates and 18% of master's degree graduates.

Chadron State College truly prepared me for success far beyond the classroom. 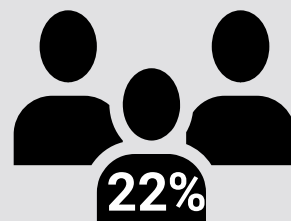

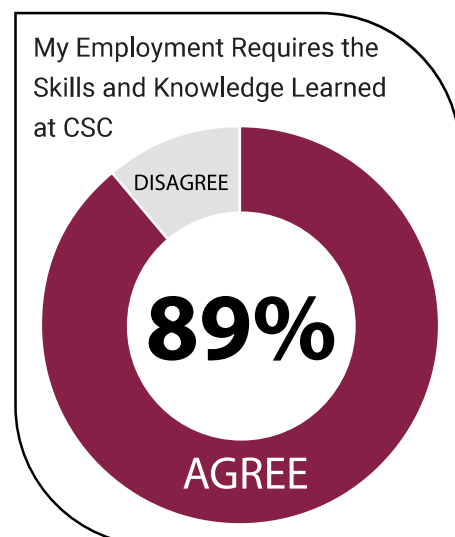

Top Industries

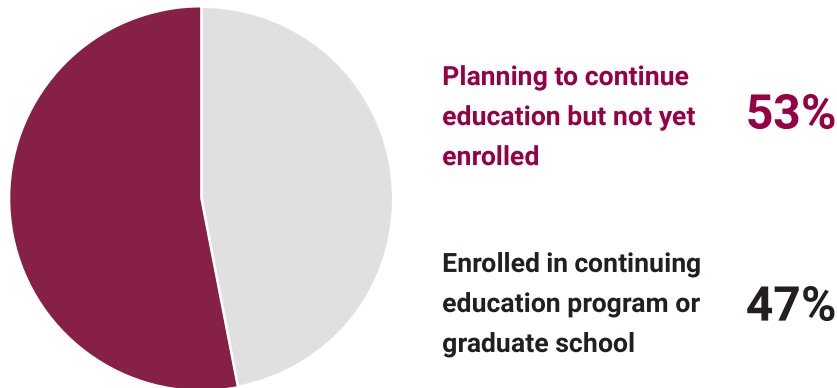
