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What is Title IX?

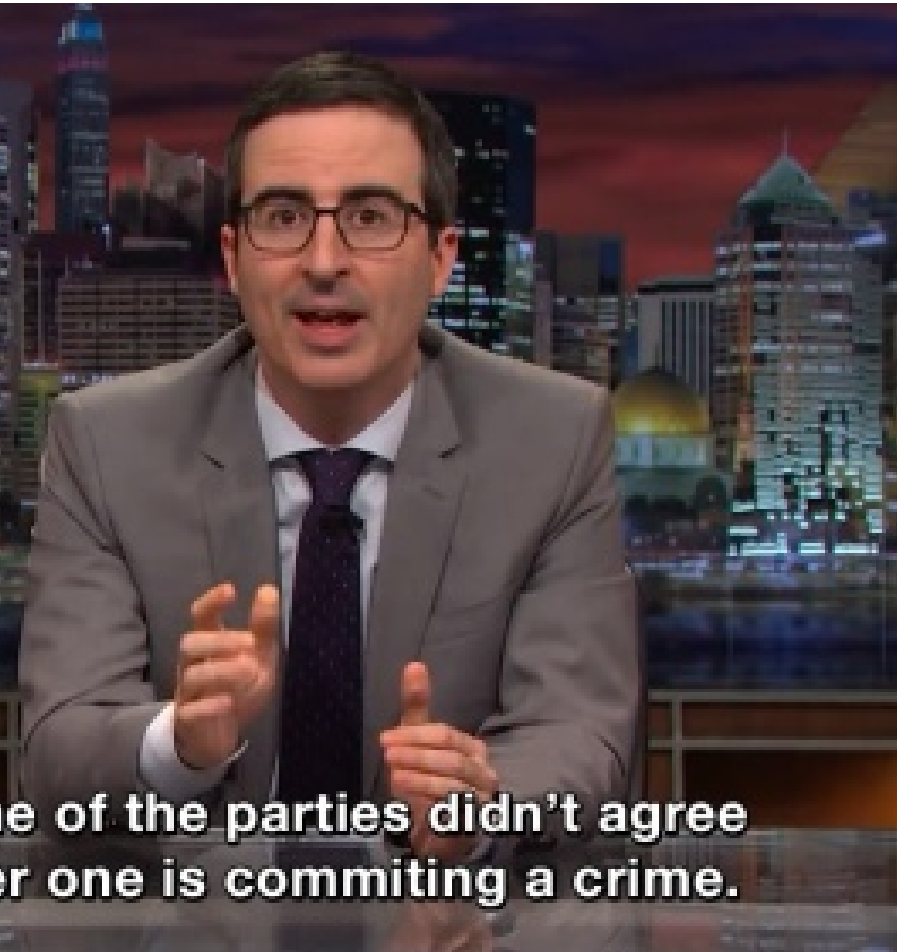
A Federal Law

Prohibits Sex Discrimination

Eliminates Barriers to Educational Opportunities

Caused by Sex Discrimination

[Avoiding touch/not touching you]
"I don't know, I want to but..."
[Turning their head or body away from you]
"Maybe..."
[Pushing you away]
"I'm not sure..."
[Lying still and not participating]
"Well, I think so..."
[Silence]

When there's uncertainty in a partner's response,
THEY ARE NOT GIVING CONSENT.



Process

- Receive complaint or notice
- Intake / Preliminary investigation – Determining reasonable cause
- Formal investigation
 - Determining Violations - PREPONDERANCE OF EVIDENCE / MORE LIKELY THAN NOT
 - Retaliation
 - Quid Pro Quo
- Deliver findings

Factors

- ALCOHOL
 - 9 out of 10 Title IX complaints/investigations include alcohol use
 - Affects capacity to consent
- Sexual Assault is the only crime that perpetrators justify alcohol as an excuse.
 - I, he, she was drunk



Bystander Intervention

how you can help a friend

- Step in and offer assistance
 - Make sure it is safe for you to do so, if necessary and the situation is dangerous call 911
 - Don't leave. Be that awkward third wheel. If you remain at the scene the is less likely the perpetrator is going to do anything.
 - If you know the perpetrator, tell the person that it is wrong.
 - She/he is too drunk and lets do the right thing and get them help.
 - Time for her/him to go home
 - Create a distraction
 - Drunks like shiny objects....
