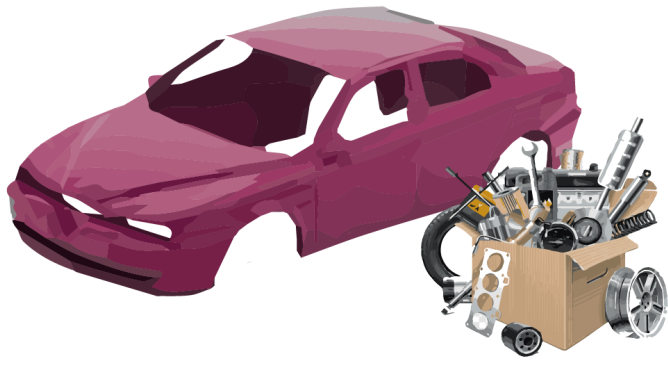

Avoid using costly publisher content for courses



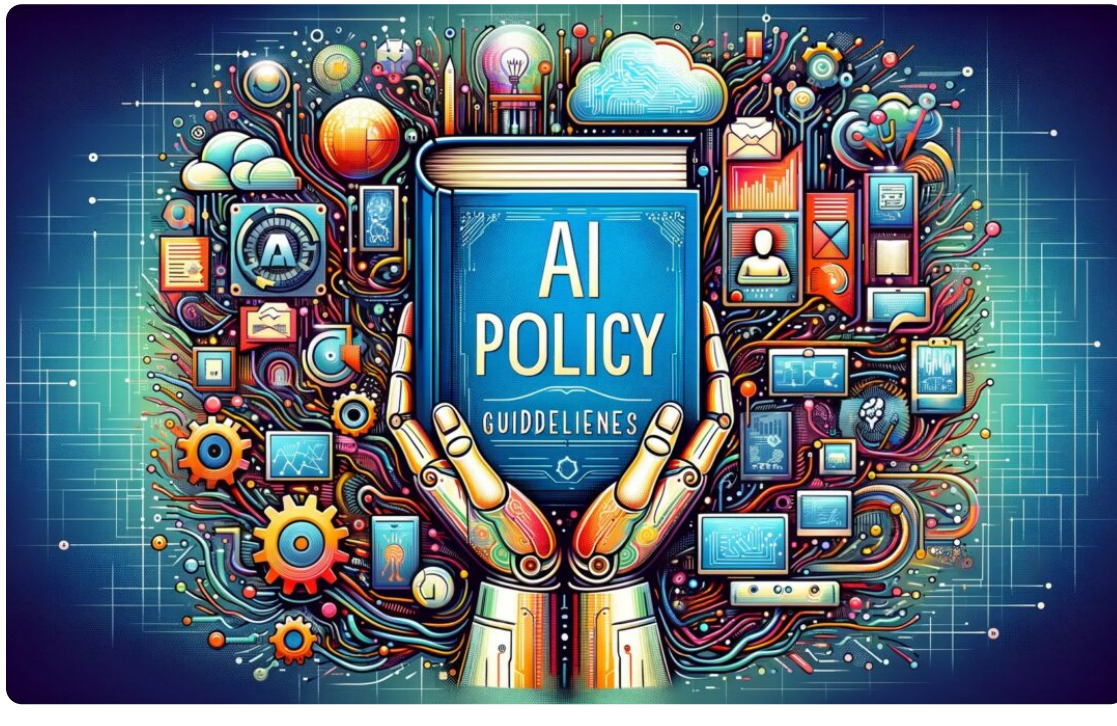

Join and learn how to:

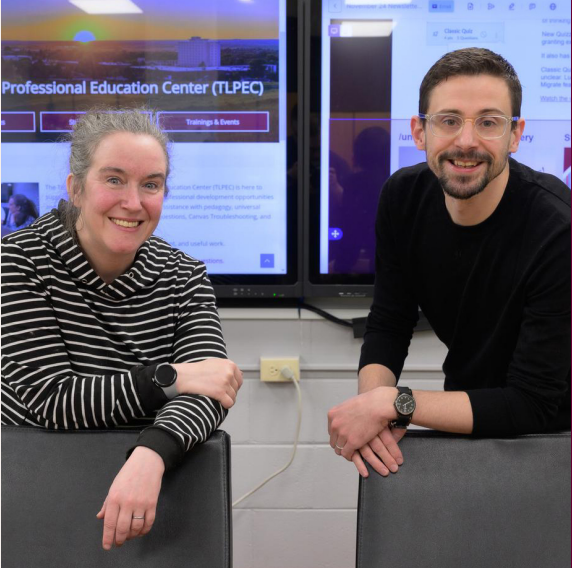
Spot and explain AI bias. Show students how to recognize and challenge AI's systematic errors, just like human biases.
